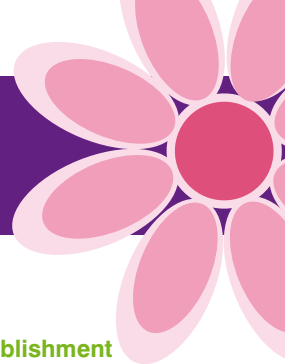
Competition Rules

- 1 Open free of charge to everyone within the Torbay Council Boundary.
- 2 All applications must be completed and received by 18th June.
- 3 All entries, except Environmentally Friendly Garden, School Project, Garden vegetable patch/allotment plot and Holiday Park categories will be judged from the highway or public footpath and must also be visible to the general public.
- 4 Only residents/businesses within the street warden scheme areas can enter the Street Warden Area category.
- 4 Please note your entry is judged from the pavement edge to the garden.
- 5 Judging will be carried out by independent judges at any time during the whole month of July (Photographic records may be taken).
- 6 A calling card will be left after the initial judging visit to let you know you have been judged.
- 7 A portfolio is required for the Community Environment Project, detailing achievements of the last 12 months.
- 8 Special Commendation Category - all entries must be submitted on a separate sheet of paper. The names and addresses of the nominator and nominee and an explanation of why the nominee deserves the award must be stated.
- 9 All the previous year's category winners will be automatically entered into the Superclass Category and will be ineligible to enter any other category. Previous year's Superclass entries are eligible to enter the categories of their choice.
- 10 You can enter into a maximum of 3 categories.
- 11 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed and highly commended certificate winners will be invited to a presentation evening in October.
- 12 The judges' decision will be final. Therefore, no correspondence or complaint will be entered into.
