

GAMBLING ACT 2005

Return relating to a Small Society Lottery to which Schedule 11, Part 4 of the Act applies

The following information is required by Schedule 11, Part 4, paragraph 39(2) of the Gambling Act 2005. This Return must be submitted **no later than three months** beginning with the day on which the draw (or the last draw) in the lottery took place. It must be signed by two members of the Society appointed in writing for that purpose by the Society, or its governing body if applicable, **and accompanied by a copy of that appointment**. All signatories must be over 18.
